## 2025 Coaches Code of Conduct

- The Head Coach assumes full responsibility for his or her actions, the actions of any assistant coaches, players and respective spectators.
- All coaches are expected to abide by all League Rules of Play.
- Verbal and/or physical abuse of players or referees will not be tolerated regardless of the circumstances.
- Profanity, taunting, trash talking, or bullying of any kind to your players, other players, coach, spectators, or game officials will not be tolerated.
- Consumption of alcohol, tobacco products or illegal drugs before or during any IEFA game is strictly forbidden.
- Coaches are expected to exhibit GOOD Sportsmanship at all times (be gracious in victory and dignified in defeat).
- Positive support of other IEFA Teams and their participants is an expectation and requirement of all coaches.
- Coaches are expected to treat everyone with the utmost respect; you not only represent your team but the entire League.

Any violation of this code will be brought to the attention of the Executive Board in the manner set forth in the IEFA By-laws and Rules.

This Code of Conduct shall be construed in conjunction with and not contrary to any existing rules and/or guidelines which govern the IEFA.
